## EFP publishes information for 10<sup>th</sup> lineup of aspiring European producers in Cannes

### Films of PRODUCERS ON THE MOVE selected for the Cannes International Film Festival

**PRODUCERS

Chosen for their outstanding work, 23 up-and-coming producers from across Europe are traveling to Cannes for the 10<sup>th</sup> edition of the PRODUCERS ON THE MOVE programme, May 16-19. Two participants of European Film Promotion's (EFP) initiative moreover will be presenting their newest films in sections at this year's Cannes International Film Festival. **Jaffa**, directed by Keren Yedaya and co-produced by **Emmanuel Agneray** (Bizibi) from France, has been selected for Official Selection, Special Screening. Another co-production of Emmanuel Agneray, **The History of Aviation** directed by Balint Kenyeres, has been selected for the Directors Fortnight. Croatia's participant **Ankica Jurić Tilić** (Kinorama) sees **Party (Tulum)**, directed by Dalibor Matanić, screened in the Semaine de la Critique (Critic's Week)/ Short films.

Supported by the **MEDIA Programme** of the EU, PRODUCERS ON THE MOVE aims to promote emerging European producers and to support cross-border collaborations between aspiring European production companies. Films of former PRODUCERS ON THE MOVE selected for various sections at Cannes 2009 are proof of the quality of the initiative's participants.
