**Deadline: 30.4.2007**

The Producers Network was launched in 2004 and it takes advantage of the accumulation of international film professionals at the Cannes Film Festival to maximise networking opportunities.

The Producers Network is reserved for **producers who have produced at least one feature film that was theatrically released in the last 3 years**. Registration is limited to 2 producers per company and it also includes access to the Marché du Film and the Festival de Cannes. **Selection is not made on the basis of a project, but on the basis of company's production experience.**

**Breakfast Meetings:** a series of thematic roundtable discussions every morning, gathering about 200 industry professionals. Each table is 'hosted' by a moderator with a specific industry background, who animates the discussion between a guest of honour and a group of high profile producers. Breakfast Meetings provide the ideal conditions to share expertise and identify potential producing partners.

**Launched in 2007:** two sessions of **speed-dating** between producers will be organized. A producer will be seated with other producers from different countries according to a schedule provided in advance.

- **Speed-dating between Producers Network members:** English language session strictly for producers registered with the Producers Network.
- **Speed-dating between French-speaking producers:** French language session strictly for French speaking producers attending the Festival de Cannes.

**The Producers Network Club:** located at the heart of the Village International – Pantiero, it provides a more relaxed setting to meet with fellow producers, the film directors from the nearby Atelier du Festival and other film professionals.

The Producers Network is designed to stimulate production and promote international co-production opportunities in today's competitive and dynamic market.
